NTT-AT and Kyung Hee University signed MOU to accelerate accepting students as interns

NTT Advanced Technology Corporation (NTT-AT, Headquarters: Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo, President and CEO: Tadashi Ito) and the Kyung Hee University (Administration: Seoul, South Korea, Dean of Students office: Hyun Jin Choi) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on March 28, 2024, to accelerate accepting students as interns from Kyung Hee University.

■Background

NTT-AT and Kyung Hee University decided to further strengthen the relationship to accumulate business experience for students and to expand human networks between Japan and South Korea for the future.

At NTT-AT, it is becoming increasingly difficult to acquire IT human resources in Japan, we have been pushing forward with the employment of foreign engineers since 2019. This MOU agreement will accelerate accepting students as interns to expand this initiative.

This is the first time for NTT-AT to sign an MOU with universities in South Korea.
