NTT-AT and the School of Electrical and Electronics Engineering at Hanoi University of Science and Technology signed MOU to accelerate accepting students as interns

NTT ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY CORPORATION (NTT-AT, Headquarters: Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo, President and CEO: Tadashi Ito) and the School of Electrical and Electronics Engineering at Hanoi University of Science and Technology (SEEE, Administration: Hanoi, Vietnam, Dean of SEEE: Nguyen Huu Thanh) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on February 23, 2026, to accelerate accepting students as interns from SEEE.

1. Background

NTT-AT and SEEE decided to further strengthen the relationship to accumulate business experience for students and to expand human networks between Japan and Vietnam for the future.

NTT-AT has been actively advancing the recruitment of global engineers since 2019 as part of its efforts to create an environment in which IT professionals with diverse backgrounds can fully realize their potential. These initiatives aim to support the Company's sustainable business growth and the creation of new businesses over the medium to long term.

The signing of this MOU represents a further enhancement of these efforts. Through this agreement, NTT-AT seeks to expand opportunities for future talent to experience Japanese companies and the business environment, while also accelerating the acceptance of internship students.

This is the first time for NTT-AT to sign an MOU with universities in Vietnam.
